Cookies

What are cookies and how does Moncaster use them?

Cookies are small data information files that are stored during a visit to our website on the device where you visit our website, such as a computer, tablet, smartphone or smartwatch.

What we are talking about "cookies" below, we refer to other similar techniques.

Cookies make it possible to recognise your web browser. In this way we can operate our website better, we can gain insight into the visitor behaviour on the website and other parties can gain insight into your surfing behaviour, so that they can show personalised advertisements about multiple websites and can leave non-relevant advertisements.

Moncaster uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies:

Functional cookies

These cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of our website. For example, they make sure that the desired information is displayed quickly and accurately each time you visit our website. No authorisation is required to place functional cookies.

Analytical cookies

We use these cookies for the analysis of our website. For example, we would like to know how often you visit our website and which pages you click on. These analytical cookies do not have a great impact on privacy, so no permission needs to be requested.

Tracking cookies

These cookies can follow your browsing behaviour on our website only.

How does Moncaster obtain your personal data?

Moncaster has data about you because you have provided us with that information. This can be done by subscribing to newsletters, participating in promotions or by other means. Moncaster will always ask for authorisation to use your data.

What personal data does Moncaster process?

Moncaster can process the following personal data:

How long does Moncaster store personal data?

Special and / or sensitive personal data processed by Moncaster

However, we can not verify if a visitor is over 16 years of age. We encourage parents to participate in their children's online activities, in order to avoid collecting information about children without parental consent. View, modify or delete data

To protect your privacy, we ask that you make a legible photo of your passport and your official identification service number of your country. Moncaster will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within a period of approximately four weeks.

Receivers of personal data and transmission to third parties

Moncaster will not sell your data to third parties and will only provide it if necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. With companies that process your data in our assignment, we closed with them an agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Moncaster remains responsible for these processing operations.

How we protect personal data

Moncaster takes the protection of your data seriously and takes appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorised access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorised modification.
